

# REFLECTION

**E**te whanau a te Karaiti, nau mai, haere mai, ki tenei whare karakia. Welcome to the Transitional Cathedral, to this house of prayer, the broad tent with a wide open door.

This morning at the 10:00am Liturgy the Cathedral will be keeping Remembrance Sunday. This is observed on the Sunday nearest 11 November which is the anniversary of the armistice at the end of World War I when that terrible conflict finally came to an end with the signing of an armistice between Germany and the Allied powers. On the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month, the guns fell famously silent. Yesterday I attended a wreath laying ceremony at the Bridge of Remembrance as part of the City of Christchurch's commemoration of the end of WWI. This morning there will be an Act of Remembrance during the Liturgy. We will pray for those whose lives have been, and continue to be, disfigured by war and the consequences of armed conflict, and we will pray in penitence and faith for reconciliation between the nations, that all people may together, live in freedom, justice and peace.

At Evensong today Bishop Victoria will install two new Canons to Chapter. One is a Diocesan clerical Canon, The Rev'd Mandy Neil, and the other is a new Diocesan Lay Canon, Carole Muir. Both of these people were appointed by Standing Committee for an initial term of three years. The remaining current members of Chapter are: Bishop Victoria Matthews and Chancellor Jeremy Johnson and myself as Dean (all ex-officio members), the Rev'd Canons Sue Baldwin, Ben Truman, Helen Roud as clerical canons, and Tony Hughes-Johnson, Malcom Rickerby and Rosemary Allison as lay canons. Please continue to pray for the members of Chapter in their role of ensuring good governance for the Cathedral and supporting the mission and proclamation of the Gospel from this place. Welcome to all who are here to support the new canons this evening.

It is also a delight to welcome former choristers to be part of the Choir this evening. This year we have a good number of former members of the choir returning to rejoin the choir, to renew relationships, to bring back fond memories of music making, and to join in with the Cathedral's offering of thanksgiving and praise to God. If you are part of this group, welcome back! Welcome also to your friends and supporters.

Next Sunday morning there will be the Baptism of Victoria Steele, for whom many of us have been praying over the last few months. Please pray for her this week as she prepares for this important step in her journey of faith..
